

CREATIVE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

Creative Arts Scholarships can be awarded for Art and/or Design & Technology

ASSESSMENT: ART

1. Portfolio

Candidates should submit a selection of recent artwork that demonstrates:

- Enthusiasm and a genuine interest in the subject
- Independent work
- · A high standard of observational drawing
- A willingness and ability to experiment with different mediums and techniques

2. Interview

The interview will take the form of an informal chat with the candidate, whilst looking at their portfolio. We will be looking for:

- · Interest in and enthusiasm for art
- Potential for future involvement in art at Terra Nova and senior school
- Knowledge of artists and wider interest in the subject

3. Assessment

Candidates will be given a 45 minute drawing task



ASSESSMENT: DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

1. Portfolio

Candidates should submit a portfolio of work that demonstrates:

- · A genuine enthusiasm for design and making
- · A high standard of technical drawing, especially 3D drawing skills
- Details of projects made in their own time. These could be from any area of the Design Technology curriculum including but not limited to Engineering, Fashion Design, Furniture Design, Wood/Metalworking, Product Design or Graphic Design

2. Interview

The interview will take the form of an informal chat with the candidate, they will be asked to talk through their portfolio and explain the design process that they followed for each project

3. Assessment

There will be a short assessment which will take the form of a product analysis. Candidates will be asked to examine a product, draw and label it and comment on key design elements that they can note in the product



CREATIVE ARTS: SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

Opportunities within school:

- Creative Arts Scholars will be expected to attend the scholars' weekly Art/ DT club
- Creative Arts Scholars will be expected to display a willingness to assist with creative arts projects around the school, such as creating sets for school productions or installations for the Forest School
- Creative Arts Scholars will be expected to set an excellent example to TN pupils at all times, produce a high level of work in Art/ DT lessons and share their creative art skills with others

Opportunities out of school:

- Creative Arts Scholars will be expected to enter creative competitions hosted by senior schools and external organisations, often on a national scale
- Creative Arts Scholars will have the opportunity to visit galleries and exhibitions, relevant to their studies, guided by their teachers

Future Schools:

- Creative Arts Scholars will be encouraged to try for scholarships to their chosen future school
- Creative Arts Scholars will receive full support in their application for Art/ DT scholarships at their chosen future school
- Creative Arts Scholars will benefit from focused sessions covering portfolio preparation, interview practice and examination technique
